

Interested in learning about the Kissimmee River and the largest river restoration in the world?

Florida Atlantic University's (FAU) Center for Environmental Studies at Riverwoods Field Lab offers field-based environmental science and education programs for students, educators, and adults via motorized kayaks. Our Eco-tours offer participants a first-hand view of the Restoration Project illustrating the inter-disciplinary nature of environmental science and management. You learn about the watershed as you explore the biological habitats of the river to see the birds, gators and fish rebounding. Wear sneakers, comfortable field clothes and bring your own picnic lunch to enjoy along the river.

The workshops are flexible to meet the needs of the group. A minimum of four hours is necessary, but a typical day is from 10 am – 3 pm.
