# Miami-Dade County's Urban CO<sub>2</sub> Reduction Program

- 1991 Miami-Dade County one of the first twelve international urban jurisdictions participating in International Council for Local Environmental Initiatives' (ICLEI) Cities for Climate Protection (CCP) Program
- Steering committee established to gather global warming science data, identify GHG emission sources, and identify opportunities for reduction
- 1993 Long Term Urban CO<sub>2</sub> Reduction Plan formally adopted
- Program Goal = Reduce CO<sub>2</sub>
   emissions by 20% of 1988 baseline by 2005

#### ICLEI's CCP 5 Milestones

- 1. Baseline emissions inventory & forecast
- 2. Adopt emissions reduction target for forecast
- 3. Develop a local Action Plan (CO<sub>2</sub> Plan)
- 4. Implement Policies & Measures
- 5. Monitor & verify results / Quantify carbon avoided





## Climate Change Advisory Task Force

- 2003 Ad-hoc committee established = Climate Change Adaptation Task Force
- Ordinance # 06-113 passed in July 2006, officially establishing the Climate Change Advisory Task Force (CCATF)
- CCATF members appointed by the Mayor, Manager, and Commissioners
- Five committees established to tackle climate change adaptation and mitigation issues
- CCATF will put forth reports and recommendations for action
